Church, 50 Lodi Street, Hackensack, NJ 07601**. You should already have received a “save the date” invitation card earlier announcing some of the details of this day.

You will recall that *Convivenza* is an Italian word which means literally, “a living together” and this is an opportunity for all of the members of Our Lady of the Angels Regional Fraternity to come together in fraternal life for a day of sharing, community and formation. We look forward eagerly to Father Jud’s presentation, on a topic to which he has devoted his ministry.

Each year, our host fraternity, St. Francis Fraternity in Hackensack, holds a Baby Shower for Birth Right and Several Sources. Everyone is invited to bring an unwrapped baby gift to be donated to these charities.

At our Convivenza, you will receive written information concerning our **Regional Retreat** which this year will be held on the weekend of **August 2-4, 2013** at the beautiful **Mt. As we will be together for August 2<sup>nd</sup>, we will be able to celebrate our great Regional Patronal Feastday, Our Lady of the Angels!
